



InfBase: Time and Place

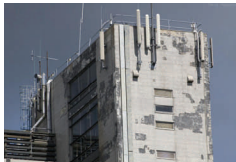
InfBase is in room 4.14 off the open area on level 4 in Appleton Tower.

InfBase

InfBase supports student learning by providing a way of getting answers to questions when you need them. For first and second years **InfBase** will be able to answer most things you throw at it. For later years and the MSc, **InfBase** will both answer some questions and provide a sounding board to help you refine your questions so you get better and more useful answers from lecturers and tutors.

You can just drop-in on **InfBase** or arrange an appointment on the **InfBase** wiki. Usually at least three people will be available in **InfBase**.

InfBase publishes all questions and answers on the **InfBase** wiki to form a growing repository of knowledge about courses.
