

What did we learn in Computer Literacy 1? - A mock examination paper

This assignment is designed to make you familiar with the nature of questions you will be confronted with in your real Computer Literacy 1 examination. For this assignment you are allowed to use your lecture slides and notes for help, but please be aware that this won't apply for your real examination.

Please answer each question. If possible use a computer and word document to do so, though submission is in hard copy. Part A requires short answers, while Part B requires a short essay as an answer. The total for this assignment is 25 marks.

Part A

 - (iii) What is a URL needed for? [2 marks]**

Part B (essay question)
