

Final Demo Day

Demo slots will be one and a half hours each and run between 9am and 5pm.

NB: unlike with previous demos, there is no setup time built into these sessions. Instead, you should arrive up to 20 minutes beforehand to set up.

Structure:

- 30 min presentation and demo.
 - This should show all of the important functionality of your system.
- 40 min discussion with clients.
 - This is an opportunity for clients to ask for more details that were missing from your presentation.
 - Be prepared to demonstrate any aspect of your system, as clients may want to see something you haven't showed, or check the robustness of something you did show.
- 10 min for the clients to discuss privately with each other. During this time you should start clearing up.
- 10 min for clients to feed back to you.

You will then have 10 minutes further to tidy up before the next group arrives to set up.
