

## AT Level 3 Covid-19 Rules

Do not attend the labs in Appleton Tower if you display any of the following symptoms:-

- New continuous cough and/or
- High temperature
- Loss of taste or smell

Lab access is limited to 9am-5pm Mondays to Fridays.

Lab access is for essential practical work only.

Upon arrival on level 3 or 4 wash your hands with soap and water at the sinks in the kitchen areas or use the hand sanitiser stations and continue to wash/sanitize your hands regularly whilst you are working in the labs.

All SDP students are expected to sign in and out via the SDP Sign in books, which can be found on Levels 3 and Levels 4.

Clean any communal surfaces that you are likely to touch before and after use.

Follow the Scottish Government guidance and The University of Edinburgh's rules on wearing face coverings. Currently this being to wear non-medical grade face coverings whilst in University buildings and study spaces.

Familiarise yourself with the Covid-19 signage around the building.

Adhere to the social distancing rules of staying 2m apart from others.

Follow the one-way system routes.

Do not enter any rooms when the maximum user number size has been reached.

For the purposes of SDP, each group has been allocated dedicated working space on Level 3 or Level 4 and only 2 members per group should use their work space at any given point in time.

Only use the two spaces that are marked with the socially distanced numbered stickers.
