- Hard to find beginning and end of answers, cramped writing
- Lack of picture/example
- Unclear/ambiguous statements

Good answers

- Short
- Use Bullet points/lists
- Diagrams, examples
- Simple, unambiguous statements
- Make it easy to find a reason to give you marks.
- Read the question carefully. It is being asked to test a particular knowledge/understanding.
- Don't rush. Take time to understand the question
