







Labyrinths vs. Mazes

Labyrinths

- Single route
- Outcome predetermined, fixed
- Follow the paths as directed
- Obedience, submission
- Safety, predictability, certainty
- Since antiquity

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Mazes

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- Outcome depends on route chosen
- Make choices and take responsibility
- Autonomy, reason, intellect
- Risk, adventure, discovery, invention, the unexpected
- Since C17
